USER INTERFACE


☞ The user interface (UI) is the body of your app



☞ Here you define its outer appearance — its style and where the single components (text, table, visualizations, ...) are placed

☞ A simple UI can look like this:

```
ui <- fluidPage(                               DEFINES THE
  titlePanel("Your Title"),                   TITLE
  sidebarLayout(sidebarPanel(
    DEFINES LEFT SIDEBAR PANEL
    (WHERE SELECTION HAPPEN)
  ),
  mainPanel(
    PLACE YOUR PLOT
  )
)
```



SERVER


☞ The server is the brain of your app



☞ Here is the place where all the calculation happens

☞ A simple server can look like this:

```
server <- function(input, output) {
  output$first_plot <- renderPlot({
    HERE GOES YOUR
    REGULAR PLOT
    FUNCTION
  })
}
```



Combine both and run your app 🎉

```
shinyApp(ui = ui, server = server)
```
